We plan to have two services each Sunday at 9:15 AM and 11:00 AM.

During both services,

- the **Venue** will be open with attendees required to wear masks in that space. The service will be live with music and other elements and the sermon will be watched on the screen. Attendees should enter and leave through doors at that end of the building
- children's programs will be offered for Nursery through Pre-k

Protocols for Safer Worship

Pre-Arrival:

- Stay home if
 ...you are feeling sick,
 have a fever, a cough or
 other symptoms.
 ...you have a sick
 family member at home.
 ...you feel unsafe
 worshipping in person.

- Please come ready to be considerate of others and their legitimate concerns about contracting or spreading the virus.
- Know that before each service, frequently touched surfaces will be wiped down to keep things clean and disinfected.

Arrival:

- The doors will be propped open or greeters will hold them open so you don't need to touch surfaces.
- No handshakes or hugs.
- There will be hand sanitation stations for you to utilize.
- If you are able, we ask that you wear a mask while you are moving around in the building. You may take your mask off once you are seated.
- Be conscious of the sixfoot social distancing guidelines recommended by the CDC.

During the Service:

- Please do not sit down within two chairs of someone from a different household. The chairs in the Auditorium and the Venue will be set up to accommodate six-foot spacing between each row.
- We will not be passing the plates for offering. We will have boxes to drop off your offerings in the foyer or you can give online.
- If you begin coughing or sneezing, please be considerate of others and cover your mouth with a tissue, mask, or your elbow.

After the Service:

- You will be dismissed by rows. If you are able, please put your mask back on until you are outside.
- Please do not linger in the worship spaces, lobby, in front of nursery or stairwells
- Exit through the doors closest to the Service space you attended.
- If you would like to talk with others after the service, we are recommending you do it outside, maintaining proper social distancing.

Additional Notes:

- We are evaluating how to have some of our Discipleship Hour programming and are making decisions on a case-by-case basis for groups that desire to meet.
- We will do temperature checks and CDC health screening for all Children's Ministry volunteers and children who join the children's programs. This includes requiring that volunteers with sick children stay home if children have had a fever within 48 hours. Volunteers are required to wear masks but children five years old and under do not need to wear a mask unless parents want them to.
- If a person with COVID-19 attends services, we will return to online services for one week to allow 13 days between services to assess the impact on the congregation. This will be done on a case-by-case basis.
