

Child Safety Plan

Goals

- 1. To prevent abuse, whether verbal, sexual, or physical.
- 2. To give parents, as well as young people and children, people of mind that we are doing everything possible to provide a safe environment.
- 3. To protect volunteers from false accusations.
- 4. To protect our church from lawsuits.
- 5. To protect the name of the Lord.
- 6. To implement procedures that help us fulfill the legal requirements of the State of Michigan.

Selection and Screening

- 1. Student workers (7th grade—age 17) will be approved through the Student Ministry and must complete a Student Impact Ministry agreement with their parent's/guardian's consent.
- 2. Adult workers (age 18 and older) will be approved through the following process:
 - a. Adult workers must be members of North Park Baptist Church.
 - b. All adult applicants who wish to serve with minors must complete a Child Safety Application Form:
 - i. Complete and return the application
 - ii. Have a personal interview
 - iii. A background check and personal reference check will be done on all applicants.
 - iv. A person who has sexually abused a minor will be disqualified from working with minors.
 - c. Applicants should attend services regularly and be involved in activities at NPBC a minimum of six months before serving with minors.
 - d. Workers will complete a Child Safety Renewal Application every 2 years.

Supervision

- 1. All workers must avoid any wrongdoing or the appearance of conduct or conversation that could be interpreted as indiscreet.
- 2. Workers are expected to adhere to the specific guidelines for their ministry.
- 3. Workers are not to be with children or youth in secluded areas.
- 4. The monitoring procedure includes a supervisor periodically observing the nursery, classrooms, and other areas where activities are taking place, including overnight events.
- 5. Ideally in group settings, such as the nursery, 2/3's, and Pre-K/K classes, there will be at least two adult workers or one adult worker and two teen workers. At least one supervisor should be a female and at least 18 years old, and at least one worker should not be an immediate family member to the others.
- 6. All parents must complete a NPKids registration card each year. Children Nursery 3rd grade will be given a name tag to wear on Sunday mornings and parents will be given a family ID tag. When picking up children from class please return both child's tag and parent tag to the staff at the NPKids desk.
- 7. Kids Connection parents must fill out a "Release Form" that specifies those who are allowed to check out their child from Kids Connection.
- 8. This Child Safety Plan will be reviewed with all workers annually.

Report and Response Plan

- 1. Report
 - a. Report any suspicious or risky behavior to the Children's Ministry Director or Executive Pastor.
- 2. Response Plan
 - a. An Immediate Response Committee shall be formed promptly, as deemed necessary. This committee will include the Lead Pastor, the Executive Pastor, the Children's Ministry Director, and an attorney ex officio.
 - b. An attorney's advice will be sought for guidance on reporting the allegation to the insurance company, civil authorities, and the parents or guardians.
 - c. The committee will take appropriate steps to implement State of Michigan guidelines for reporting alleged abuse or neglect.
 - d. An attorney's advice will be sought on communication to the congregation and media.
